ANNUAL REPORT 2018-2019

The activities of N.S.S for the academic year 2018-2019 begin on 11th June 2018. A meeting of NSS Volunteers were held on 11th June at 1pm in the College Auditorium. Principal Dr. K S Kurian presided over the meeting. During the meeting Mr. Binu Kurian, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce is take the charge of NSS Programme Officer. Ms. Feba Simon, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce is take the charge of NSS Assistant Programme Officer. The Programme Officer presents the action plan which were going to conduct during the year. The meeting comes to an end on 1.30pm.

A meeting of NSS Volunteers were held on 18th June at 1.15 pm in the College Auditorium under the leadership of NSS Programme Officer. The meeting began with NSS Song. The programme officer gave instructions regarding the programme going to conduct on 21st June, on the occasion of International Yoga Day. NSS Programme Officer appoints Mr. Jomy Thomas and Ms.Dona Alphonsa Antony were as the volunteer secretaries. The meeting ends on 1.30pm.

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A meeting of students who wish to join NSS were held on 25th July 2018 at 1.15pm in College auditorium. Principal Dr. KS Kurian presided over the meeting. NSS Programme Officer explain the emergence and basic concepts of NSS and the benefit which were got through NSS. As we all know, nowadays Kerala is facing a difficult condition because of the huge flood. So the NSS Unit of St. Antony's college, Peruvanthanam decided to help the flood affected people of Kuttanad region in the meeting held on 16.8.2018 under the supervision of NSS Programme Officer. After the meeting, the idea was shared with students and fund was collected from them. The students and teachers extend full support for the great work.the NSS unit contacted Rev. Fr. Prasoon Chakkumkal, Vicar, Lourd Matha Church, Chennamkary and he extended whole hearted support and encouragement for the venture. With the collected funds from the teachers and students, food items and other things were bought under the supervision of the NSS Programme

Officer and Volunteer secretary. Under the leadership of Mr. Binu Kurian, the programme officer and Mr. Basil PN, HOD Malayalam Department, NSS Volunteers went to Kuttanad. Dr. K.S Kurian, the college principal addressed before the journey. The team reached at Kuttanad by Noon and handed over the collected things to the team arrived by the directions of Chennamkary parish vicar. It was a great experience for the volunteers. By this work our NSS unit also became a part of the survival of kuttanad.

As part of Shuchitwa Kerala Mission of Government of Kerala, various cleaning programmes were conducted by the NSS unit of St. Antony's college Peruvanthanam. On 21st September 2018, a cleaning programme was conducted in the premise of the college. As we all know the usage of plastic is very badly affecting our nature and also the usage of plastic is also increasing day by day in an uncontrolled manner. So the main aim of this cleaning programme was to eradicate plastic from the college campus. After the inaugural ceremony, the camp was given a head start by Mr. Binu Kurian, NSS Programme Officer, who gave all NSS volunteers a pre-orientation class and guidelines for the smooth conduct of the programme. Under the supervision of Mr. Jomy Thomas and Miss Dona Alphonsa, volunteer secretaries, programme officer divided the volunteers into different groups. Miss Chinnu S, faculty from St. Antony's College joined the camp on the first day. The day's programme began at 6 pm with a seminar on "Success Manthra" by Mr. Tomy Dominic, Vice Principal of St. Antony's College. After supper students conducted various cultural programmes. First days programmes came to an end by 11 pm after presenting the repor by the volunteer secretary.

The second day of the programme started with an assembly and parade. After breakfast the school premise was cleaned by the volunteers. After cleaning, the students cultivated a vegetable garden and built a small pond in the school campus. By 6 p.m Mrs.Sanusha, faculty from career and guidance institute, Kattappana led a class on the topic "Leadership". After the class dinner was served. The chief guest of the event was Mr.A.L. Sabu;as it was X'mas eve, the chief guest delivered a X'mas message and sweets were distributed. After cake cutting ceremony students performed various cultural activities. By 10:30 p.m Prof M.J Mathew, NSS programme coordinator MG university visited the camp and communicated with the students. The second day programmes woundup after analyzing the day's report.

The third day of the NSS camp began at 8:30a.m after assembly and parade. Miss BeenaP.R, another faculty from St. Antony's College joined the camp for the day. Students were engaged in cleaning the school premises till noon. Afternoon session of the day began with a debate among the students which was moderated by the Programme officer. After debate, lunch was served and the students were instructed to attend a trekking programme to Thookkupalam and Kozhimala. In the evening programme officer Mr. Binu Kurian lead a seminar upon the topic 'NSS'. Various cultural programmes were conducted after the supper and programmes were concluded after presenting the report at 11 pm.

The forenoon session of the 4th day began at 6.30 am after assembly and parade. Miss. Rosemary Jacob, a faculty from department of commerce, St. Antony's College joined the camp. Volunteers were engaged in cleaning public places in the Panchayath. Students were divided into groups for cleaning public places. They cleaned a public pond which had been contaminated by flood. Mr. Wilfred chacko, Assistant professor of St. Antony's College led a seminar on the topic 'Unique Personality'. Cultural programmes were conducted after supper and volunteers were asked to share their experience. By 11'o clock the programmes of the 4th day were concluded.

The 5th day of the camp was full of events. Miss.Sancy Rose Antony, a faculty from Department of Commerce, St. Antony's College joined the camp. The day began at 6 am with assembly and parade. After breakfast students were instructed to reconstruct a wall destructed due to flood. Dr. Antony Joseph Kallampally, Head of the Department of Commerce, Henry Baker College led a seminar on the topic "Visualisation and Curiosity" in the afternoon session. After the seminar an open forum for discussion was conducted where Mr. Manoj Mathirappally, creative writer and editor in Jeevan T.V, Mr M.M Joseph

, Drama artist, Mr. Roy Thomas ,Secretary, Tourist Development Society Ayyappancoyil ,Mr. Satheesh Varkey, faculty of Kozhimala Govt. School, Mr. Manoj Joseph , Senior Clerk of Revenue department of Ayyappancoyil discussed the topics such as "Highrange subsequent to flood and Encroachment", "Scope of tourism in highrange", "Atrocities of flood", "Ayyappancoyil before 1975" respectively. Students clarified their doubts and an open discussion was conducted.

In the evening by 8 p.m Mr. Raman Rajamannan, Tribal King of Kozhimala visited the camp and spent time with the volunteers. He narrated the customs of "Mannan Community", its rituals and beliefs. At 9 pm "Mannankoothu" an ancient artform of Mannan community was performed .The fifth day's programmes were winded up by 11 pm after report reading.

The 6th day began after assembly and parade. Miss Sofina Devasia and Miss Sherin Treesa Sebastian faculties from St. Antony's College joined the camp on 6th day. In continuation to previous days programme, the forenoon session of 6th day was dedicated to cleaning the soil eroded areas. In the afternoon session students were split into groups and were sent for a survey of 150 nearby houses to know the extent of impact of flood in those areas. Every NSS volunteer was given a warm welcome from each house visited. After the survey, the survey report was analyzed and studied By 6 pm Mr. Eldo Paulose, CEO and trainer, Training Gurus Institute led a seminar on the topic "Effective Personality".
