2. The Programmes in the institution are having appropriate courses. About 42.9% of teachers strongly agree, 54.8% of teachers agree and 2.3% of teachers gave a Neutral response to the given statement.
3. The content of the course includes latest development. About 28.6% of teachers strongly agree, 69% of teachers agree and 2.4% of teachers gave a Neutral response to the given statement.
4. The course keep good balance between theory and practice. About 19% of teachers strongly agree, 69% of teachers agree. 2.5% of teachers disagree and 9.5% of teachers gave a Neutral response to the given statement.
